Did you know?

2,000 people lived in Strathgordon. It was a busy little township, with all the facilities and services the residents needed – shops and a supermarket, sporting facilities, a church, medical centre, fire service, police station and school. The houses were prefabricated in an on-site factory. Its assembly line could roll out one finished house per day. When the construction tasks were finished, the workers – and their transportable houses – moved on to build the Hydro's Pieman River Power Development. Many of those houses are still in the West Coast village of Tullah.

Today, all of Strathgordon's permanent residents are Lodge workers and Hydro employees who maintain and operate the power station. The old staff house, which was home to engineers and senior staff, initially became Lake Pedder Chalet. Recently rebranded as Pedder Wilderness Lodge, it offers a comfortable and welcoming retreat for visitors wishing to enjoy the south west, which is known for its spectacular World Heritage Area and many outdoor recreational activities, including bushwalking, paddling, fishing and photography.
